Trees vs. Turf –The Ongoing Debate Jerry Wilthew, *Maintenance Supervisor*

In the scheme of landscape design, we like to see diversity. Hardscapes, water features, beds and trees are all things we might use to make our property look pleasing. Most times we will also have turf as a part of the finished product. I think that most would say football fields and golf courses have some of the best-looking turf you can find. Obviously, the turf in those situations is the most important factor involved. In home landscaping, you have many more variables involved. Privacy, shade, aesthetics, noise reduction and maybe just environmental reasons come into play in laying out your space.



Trees and turf can coexist; however, as stated above, the healthiest turf can be found when no trees are involved. The healthiest trees are found in forests where no turf is found. I came from a golf background and tended to sacrifice trees for turf quality. My brother is from the forestry profession and he might say the worst thing for trees is turf. We both were trying to eliminate the competition. What is the happy medium? It depends on individual preference. Are you willing to sacrifice the health of your turf or trees so you can enjoy both?

Shade, water and nutrient availability and compaction (from foot/machine traffic) can be limiting factors in turf quality. All the same can be limiting factors for tree growth as well. Most times we just have a few trees, so shade is not as big a problem for their health. But one tree growing alone tends to branch out. Remember the healthiest trees grow in forests. Tall straight growth with most of branches at the top of the canopy make for healthy specimens. Lots of lower branches increase the risk of wind damage and poor growth habit which also causes more shade. You guessed right...it makes it hard to grow grass under it.

Do you like your trees but your turf is struggling? Add mulch beds, river stone or hardscapes to remove suffering areas. Would you prefer to improve the grass on your property? Remove trees and do some canopy thinning. Sunlight, air movement and drainage improvement will help turf tremendously. In either case, give us a call to improve your outdoor living space.






GET TO KNOW.... Chris White. Executive Vice President
